

Summary of TA Reviews

- Problems of Knowledge and Valuation (Two-semester introduction to philosophy for honors students)
- Introduction to Philosophy
- Contemporary Christian Philosophy

For questions 1-8, a 1 indicates "strongly disagree" while a 5 indicates "strongly agree." For question 9, a 1 indicates "Very Unsatisfactory" and a 5 indicates "Excellent."
